GENERAL INFORMATION:

- WHO CAN PLAY:** Intramural (IM) Sports activities are available to all current undergraduate and graduate students who paid full-time registration fees, as well as IM Sports Affiliates who have a current IM card, which can be purchased at the IM Office (Mon-Fri 9 AM-5 PM). **Special IM Cards, valid for this tourney only, will be sold for \$15.** Complete eligibility rules are available online at imsports.ucdavis.edu. (Intramurals – Who Can Play?).
- DROP FEES:** Make sure the individual is available to play at the start of the tournament. Should the individual drop from the tournament after the entry deadline, he/she will be assessed a \$20 drop fee.
- FORFEITS:** A forfeit constitutes (1) non-appearance, (2) late appearance (not ready to play 5 minutes after the scheduled start time), (3) use of an ineligible player (i.e., a player who is not in possession of a valid IM card or valid UCD Student ID). A forfeit by an individual will result in a fine of \$10.00 being assessed. The individual has 3 business days to protest the forfeit. Fines are automatically billed to the individual via University Billing System. If the individual is an IM card holder, he/she will need to pay that fine in person at the IM office.
- ALCOHOL:** No possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted on University property.
- EJECTION POLICY:** Any player ejected from the tournament shall be ineligible for further competition in any sport until he/she meets with the IM Director.

- CHECK IN:** Check in will begin at 5:00PM with play beginning at 6:00PM.
